Mr Jasbir Singh who heads the foundation explains how its model works "The foundation leverages and utilises the already existing infrastructure, technology and expertise available at Teleradiology Solutions which helps in eliminating the capital costs incurred on infrastructure and technology". Teleradiology Solutions also allocates a percentage of its profits to the foundation on a monthly basis for operational expenses.

Telerad Foundation uses low cost technologies to make the delivery of teleradiology services feasible to locations where high speed broadband has not penetrated. It also disseminates knowledge (via <http://www.radguru.net>) and training in the field of radiology and telemedicine to raise the overall standard of medical care in the community. It initiated a successful "Volunteer to read a scan" program which leverages a compassionate panel of radiologists across the world who give back to rural poor patients by working pro bono providing their expert diagnostic interpretational services.

Dr Arjun Kalyanpur, the founder of Teleradiology Solutions said "Our aim is to make high quality diagnostic reports available to poor patients anywhere in the world who need them. God has given us a lot, we are blessed to be able to use our domain knowledge to give back to those less fortunate."
