TS helps patients in Georgia!

Bangalore based Teleradiology Solutions radiologists helped Sachkhere Medical Center which is a 140 bed hospital serving the District of Sachkhere in rural Georgia receive medical diagnostic reports even during the recent Georgia-Russia war when fighting broke out in South Ossetia, Georgia. (The conflict over the tiny separatist province of South Ossetia began when Georgia tried to retake the pro-Russian region last week, provoking a massive counter-offensive from Moscow. The heavy fighting between Russian and Georgian forces appears to have ended after the two sides agreed to an EU-backed ceasefire plan on Aug 13 2008 early morning. The peace plan demands that Russia and Georgia immediately end all hostilities and allow free access to the region for humanitarian assistance.)

Email from Dr Konstantin at that time:

For now all administrative personnel of the hospital have been evacuated and all of us remaining are tending to the injured. Unfortunately there are a lot, and we are getting even more. *The teleradiology project we started is becoming even more necessary now for us.* I will keep you posted as much as I can as long as I have some communication channel but even this is wearing thin because a lot of cell towers have been bombed.
